Skrish split the party. Burst into a room full of doom and rolled a 1. Leaves behind his party: Kat the Druid, Bingle the Warrior, and Krag.





Copycat Warble-Bellied Cookies

These flavorful cookies were a hit at the Carver's Day Celebration! Now you can make your own and have them any time you want one. Thanks to **Elthana** for sharing her recipe!

Servings: 32 Ready in: 3 full cranks

Ingredients

2 ¾ C hand-ground flour powder
½ tsp Ashburrow rock salt
¾ tsp soda for baking
1 ½ C plains sugar
1 large egg from a flarchingale



Instructions

- Get your fire roaring hot
- Dump the ingredients in a bowl and mix them up
- Roll your dough into balls about the size of a dumfry haul
- Flatten them with your thumb
- For the "Warble Belly" add a scrapnut on top

Cook over an open flame for 3 full cranks. Enjoy warm with a cup of honeyglow apple cider!
